Frank Baillie played a key role in the creation of Squash Ontario serving on its Board for two years as treasurer. He went on to help the International Squash Rackets Federation as its secretary and when his term was completed, built The Club in Oakville which became synonymous with excellence. He was the first to bring world calibre squash to Ontario.



### GARY WAITE

Gary Waite won more titles than any other junior squash player in the history of Canadian squash. He continued this trend into the professional ranks to become one of the most accomplished professional squash players in the history of the game, at one time holding the #1 ranking in hardball and doubles and #12 in softball.
